Description: Fisher Point sits atop a beautiful sculpted sandstone cliff 433 vertical feet above the mouth of Walnut Canyon. We will get there via Sandy's Canyon Trail. The trail will start from Lake Mary Road, descending into Sandy's Canyon where we will hike along a heavily wooded trail and finally ascending to Fisher Point. The well signed first mile follows along the canyon rim with views of the Pit (a popular Flagstaff outdoor area) and then drops sharply and continues through a rocky wash to where it joins the Arizona Trial. The path smooths out and after .9 miles where we will get our first peak at Fisher Point. There is a large cave at the base. To the right is the entrance to Walnut Canyon which offers more cafes and cliff-dweller ruins. A sign directs us up the final mile to fisher point via easy switchbacks. Additional optional mileage up to two miles will be awarded for those who wish to explore Walnut Canyon.

Driving Directions: From Phoenix: take I-17 north to Lake Mary Road. Take a right and go south on Lake Mary Road. Proceed 5.1 miles to the entrance to the trail head and camp ground. Turn left and enter the recreational area. Proceed to the far north end of the area and park in the lot on the left.
