Description: VNSA is a non-profit organization that gathers used books throughout the year and then holds its annual used book sale at the Arizona State Fairgrounds the second weekend in February every year. The book sale is open 8 to 6 on Saturday and 8 to 4 on Sunday. Funds from the sale are used to support Friends of Foster Children and Literacy Volunteers of Maricopa County. In the past, VNSA has raised \$300,000 + in this very large two day sale.

Volunteers are needed at the sale to help with the massive number of customers who attend. There are a number of volunteer positions available, but I would recommend helping out as an adder/bagger. This position involves either adding up the cost of the books that a customer wishes to purchase using a 10-key calculator or bagging up the books that are being purchased. If you are volunteering with someone this is a good volunteer spot to work together. Customers will often be purchasing a shopping cart full of books so you need to be able to bend and lift items repeatedly and often items that are heavy.

There is also an Express Checkout volunteer position that also does adder/bagger duties that is less labor intensive if you are concerned about lifting heavy items.

Volunteers are needed all day Saturday for 5 hour shifts, either 8am to 1 pm or 1pm to 6 pm. I will be there all day Saturday. Lunch is provided and coffee/light snacks are available in the morning.

If you are interested in volunteering, please e-mail me and I will sign you up. Please let me know as soon as possible if you want to help out. The variety of jobs available gets fewer and fewer the closer we get to the sale, so being an adder/bagger, as I'm suggesting, might not be available if you wait until the last minute to volunteer.

The AZ State Fairgrounds charge \$7 dollars for parking, but if you are volunteering for the event I can get a free parking pass for you but I will need to give it to you before the day you volunteer.
