Description: The plan for this adventure is to ski three days at the ski resorts near Salt Lake City Utah. The inclination at the moment is to ski Park City/Canyons two days and one day at Deer Valley with the plan to stay in a hotel or condo in Park City, Utah. Airfare is currently \$240, lift tickets at Park City/Canyons for two days is \$240 and one day at Deer Valley is \$135. We might be able to get discounted lift tickets but this is the going rate at the moment. Deer Valley does not allow snowboards.
