Required Equipment: LONG PANTS, RAIN GEAR, GLOVES, STUDY FOOTWEAR, HAT, WATER, FOOD, HEAD LAMP OR FLASHLIGHT, MOLESKIN. CLOTHING APPROPRIATE FOR SUNNY AND WARM OR COLD AND WET.

Recommended Equipment: SNOW TRACKS OR INSTEP CRAMPONS IF SNOW OR ICE PRESENT, TREKKING POLES, RADIO SET TO CHANNEL 6, WARM LAYER

Cautions and Special Preparations: WEATHER THIS TIME OF YEAR IN THE CANYON IS UNPREDICTABLE. EXPECT PHOENIX TEMPERATURES AT THE BOTTOM AND FLAGSTAFF AT THE TOP. SNOW IS A POSSIBILITY. WATER AVAILABILITY: WATER IS USUALLY AVAILBLE AT INDIAN GARDENS ONLY. DO NOT PLAN TO REFILL YOUR WATER AT THE MILE AND A HALF RESTHOUSE OR THE THREE MILE RESTHOUSE UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTIFIED. THE WATER MAY NOT BE RUNNING AT THESE LOCATIONS UNTIL MAY.

Description: SEVERAL OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE. THIS HIKE IS AN INDIVIDUAL EFFORT AND IS VERY STRENUOUS. MAKE SURE THE OPTION YOU CHOOSE IS SUITABLE TO YOUR PHYSICAL CONDIITONING. OPTIONS (MILEAGE IS APPROXIMATE):
BRIGHT ANGEL TRAILHEAD TO:
 1. MILE AND A HALF RESTHOUSE AND BACK - 3.2 MILES
 2. THREE MILE RESTHOUSE AND BACK - 6.2 MILES
 3. INDIAN GARDENS AND BACK – 9.6 MILES
 4. COLORADO RIVER AND BACK – 17 MILES
SOUTH KAIBAB TRAILHEAD TO:
 5. TONTO TRAIL TO BRIGHT ANGEL TRAIL TO BRIGHT ANGEL TRAILHEAD – 13.6 MILES
 6. RIVER TRAIL TO BRIGHT ANGEL TRAIL TO BRIGHT ANGEL TRAILHEAD - 17.5 MILES

Miles will be established by GPS where possible.

Driving Directions: To South Rim Take I-17 to Flagstaff, SR-180 north out of Flagstaff or I-40 west to Williams then SR-64 and SR-180 into Grand Canyon Village. \$30 fee to enter National Park
