Cautions and Special Preparations:

Description: The plan is to fix erosion and add water bars where needed from the resent monsoon storms. Also fix the Plaques if necessary. If we have time I would like to reroute one section of the trail where it is too steep and needs a switch back. The storms were so bad this year that it snapped the flag pole into that has been there since 2009. The new flag pole is on order and should be back up hopefully July, 26, 2017. The monsoon storms for August 2018 were worst than 2017 and also did damage to the new pole. It was fixed and hopefully will last longer this time.

Driving Directions: From central Phoenix drive north on I-17 to Happy Valley Rd. and turn west. Travel west on Happy Valley just past the 303 to where Happy Valley and Vistantia Blvd. Meet. It can be confusing as Happy Valley appears to turn into Vistantia Blvd. We will meet at corner of Happy Valley and Vistantia Blvd. It is the first street just past the 303. From here we follow each other to the trail head.
