Required Equipment: Study hiking boots, 1-2 quarts of water, snacks and/or lunch (especially if you don't plan on joining us for brunch/lunch after the hike at El Encanto in Cave Creek), first aid kit, layered clothing adequate for warmth in the morning that can be peeled off as the day gets warmer, hat and sunscreen

Recommended Equipment: Trekking poles, gloves and rain gear if there is a chance for rain. A radio tuned to channel 6 is nice to have to keep track of each other when we get separated due to different paces, frequency of picture taking or just plain ol' lollygagging and enjoying the sights.

Description:
The Hike – According to All Trails (see <https://www.alltrails.com/trail/us/arizona/spur-cross-trail> for more details) the “Spur Cross Trail is a 5.2 mile lightly trafficked loop trail located near Cave Creek, Arizona that features a river and is rated as moderate. The trail offers a number of activity options and is accessible year-round. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash. This Spur Cross loop is the most popular and easiest hike of the Spur Cross Conservation Area. The views are spectacular and the Solar Oasis is an interesting place to discover.”

Driving Directions: Spur Cross ranch Conservation Area is located approximately 35 miles north of central Phoenix. Interstate 17, State Route 51, and Loop 101 can all be used to reach the park. From the intersection of Carefree Highway and Cave Creek Road head north on Cave Creek Road about 2.5 miles to Spur Cross road.

Turn north for approximately 4.5 miles to the public parking area. After 3 miles the road turns to all-weather graded.

The last 1.5 miles can be confusing; continue north on the graded road past the green house, through the tall gateposts and on past the horse corrals to the ample signed public parking area on the right where there are numerous mounds of dirt. The road is easily passable with low clearance vehicles.

The entrance to the park is a couple of hundred yards up the road, which is blocked to motor vehicles, where you will pay a \$3 fee, per person (15 years and under are free), for entry into the Conservation area. Note: fee of \$3.00 was verified on line 14 Jan 2019.

Make sure you have the correct amount of money since you can only use cash.
