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Required Equipment: Comfortable Hiking Boots/Shoes, Sunscreen, Hat, Socks, Adverse weather outer Protection, Minimum 3 Qt. Water, Lunch/Snacks, Moleskin, Flashlight, Daypack. Dress in layers.

Recommended Equipment: Trekking Poles, under boot buckle or crampons for snow/ice, Radios set to Channel 6, layers of clothes. Weather similar to Flagstaff. No water on Grandview trail.

Cautions and Special Preparations: Weather this time of year in the Canyon is highs in 60's lows in 30's, similar to Flagstaff. May have sunshine or rain. Recommend 3 quarts of water on Grandview. Over 3000 ft. elevation drop

Description: 1 day hikes, Saturday October 5 is Grandview trail to horseshoe Mesa and back. Hike is in and out so hikers can turn around at any point. 8am is planned start time.
 Advanced reservations are required for lodging and can be made thru Xanterra Parks and Resorts at 1-888-297-2757.
 Meet at Grandview trail head at Grandview point on Desert View drive at 8 am. 6.4 miles round trip and 3100 ft. elevation drop and climb back up. Hike to horse shoe Mesa, pit toilet at campground on the Mesa.
 Hike is to be completed as an individual effort based on your start time, your hiking ability. Leader staying at Bright Angel cabin Friday night.
