Cautions and Special Preparations:

It can be confusing as Happy Valley appears to turn into Vistantia Blvd. We will meet at corner of Happy Valley and Vistantia Blvd. It is the first street just past the 303. There is a traffic light there now. From here we follow each other to the trail head.
