 The plan to start from the south end of the Peavine trail and hike north on an abandon RR bed once known as the Peavine. The map shows it is about 3.7 miles to the Junction of the Iron King Trail. We will then turn around at the junction of the Iron King and Peavine trails, then return along the Peavine until we reach the junction of the Lakeshore Trail. The plan is to meander along the Watson Lakeshore Trail enjoying the scenic views of the Granite Rock outcropping, Watson Lake and Granite Mountain. Final mileage will be determined by GPS. There are Restrooms at the trailhead but forgot to note if there is drinking water. After the hike, if there is sufficient interest, we can make a stop for beverage and/or snack at an eating establishments along Hwy 69 or at Rock Springs.

**Driving Directions:** North on I-17 to the Prescott Exit 262 at Cordes Jct. Drive NW about 31.1 miles on Hwy 69, thru Prescott Valley to the Prescott Lakes Parkway (top of the hill). Turn north onto Prescott Lakes Parkway, drive about 1.9 miles till you reach the Watson Lake Watershed turnoff to the Peavine Trailhead on your left. If you have reached the stop light on Hwy 89 you have gone too far. The parking area is right across the road from the Yavapai Humane Society. There is a \$3.00 fee (Cash/CC) payable at the Parking Lot Kiosk.
